The Charles E. Barnhart Fund for Academic Excellence was created to honor Dr. Barnhart, dean of the College of Agriculture from 1969-1988. The Barnhart Fund supports activities that enhance excellence in College of Agriculture, Food and Environment programs.

Usually on an annual basis, the Barnhart Fund for Excellence Committee, comprised of faculty and staff and appointed to three-year terms by the dean, seeks proposals for projects/programs to be supported by the fund. Such proposals might include, but are not limited to workshops/conferences, nationally or internationally renowned speakers to give major presentations, programmatic initiatives with an excellence theme, and student enrichment and development activities. The Barnhart Committee receives approximately 40 applications each year and is typically able to fund 10-12.

Requests for more than \$1,000 and requests for projects and activities that have already occurred or occur before July 1, 2022 or after June 30, 2023 will not be considered. Proposals that have already been awarded funding or are submitted in any format other than on this form will not be considered. Proposals that involve students (at any level) and new initiatives receive preference. Multiple proposals from one Lead Contact do not receive preference. Recipients of the 2023 Fiscal Year Barnhart funding must conclude all expenditures by June 30, 2023.
